The Clark County Homeless Coalition operates a transitional living facility located at 25 Wainscott Ave. in Winchester and is the only shelter that serves families in the region. In the five months since the facility opened, we have sheltered 13 families, some for as long as three months. Trained staff work with residents to assist them in gaining the skills needed for long-term self sufficiency. Without Wainscott Hall, families would be forcibly separated or left on the streets.
